

Scratch art is a simple art project that use a scratching tool to remove the black layer of the project to reveal beautiful colours underneath their art.

## Instructions:

- 1. Set up resources with a tarp/cloth down on the table.
- 2. Coloring your paper with oil pastels, making sure to press really hard. Use bright colors to create any pattern to design you choose. (For example, rainbow stripes).
- 3. In a cup add some black paint and dish soap (2:0.5 ratio), the soap will help the paint stick to the oil pastels. Using a foam brush, begin painting over your oil pastel picture.
- 4.Cover the entire paper and allow it to dry. It's okay if you see some of the patterns lightly under the paint.
- 5. Using a skinny stick, start scratching a design into the paper. Try to pick a theme (under the sea).
